1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Board Chair M. Hannan Khan called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

2. MINUTES

2.A Approval of the meeting minutes from April 8, 2026 meeting.

Board Co-Chair Edward Kilroy made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 8, 2026, meeting as presented. Board Member Manuel Gomez seconded the motion.

3. HEAR AUDIENCE

Ms. Grace Gaines spoke as a representative for her non-profit Wings of Angels, Limited. She explained that this non-profit's mission is to eliminate food insecurity. She is asking for assistance in finding a place to host her event on November 24, 2026. Board Member Robin Wright clarified that Ms. Gaines was looking for a space easily accessible for the community. Board Chair M. Hannan Khan suggested connecting with local downtown churches. Board Co-Chair Edward Kilroy asked if she had spoken with others within the City about additional venues in the city. Board Member Jordan Rivera shared that this organization provided a great service to the community. Parks and Recreation Director, Steve Lackey, suggested the Council on Aging venue as a possibility for Ms. Gaines' event. He also shared that the Lakefront Park area would not be available in November due to the City Commission-approved events already in place. However, Mr. Lackey will be happy to share the process for securing this type of event next year.

Ms. Gaines filled out a comment card, and it was collected. It was inadvertently disposed of by the chairperson, so not retained. (EXHIBIT A - email verification)

4. DISCUSSION

4.A Directors Update

The following updates and events were shared by Parks and Recreation Director, Steve Lackey:

- * Lancaster Ranch phase 1B will be complete at the end of July.
- * Lancaster Ranch phase 2 final engineering design will be finalized by December. This phase is not yet fully funded.
- * The fieldhouse study report will be presented at the next PARAB meeting. The scoring between the two sites was separated by one point. This is a public/private venture.
- * Lakeside Community Center is on a permanent hold. The City is proceeding with the fire station construction.
- * The proposed Property Tax cut that will be on the November ballot is creating a need for the City to cut items from the budget. This cut could affect the fee waivers for October and November.
- * The final verbiage of the bill is finalized, and City of Kissimmee Assistant City Attorney, Curtis McGehee, provided an explanation to Board Co-Chair Edward Kilroy's question on the bill.
- * Pridefest event was a success with approximately 2,500 in attendance.
- * Juneteenth is June 13, 2026, from 12:00 to 4:00.
- * Monumental 4th of July will be held July 4th from 7:00 to 9:30.
- * On July 7, 2026, the City Commission will recognize Parks & Recreation month with a proclamation. PARAB members are invited to attend and receive the proclamation.
- * Parks & Recreation Open House is scheduled for August 22, 2026, at Oak Street Park.

* The City Commission will have a public hearing in August to rebrand Ruby Plaza the Hanson Plaza in honor of Guillermo Bill Hansen.

5. NEW BUSINESS

5.A Fee Waiver Grant

Viva Osceola — Parks & Recreation Director, Steve Lackey, shared that three out of the four events are signature events. With a signature event, the City waives the cost of Public Safety. Board Co-Chair Edward Kilroy stated that he took 5 points off Viva Osceola's score because it was stated in the packet that they were not involved with any other groups. Each board member read their scores (Exhibit B) for Viva Osceola as staff recorded the scores onto the spreadsheet displayed (Exhibit C). Board Co-Chair Edward Kilroy made a motion to award Viva Osceola \$4,328.00 and Board Member Jordan Rivera seconded the motion.

6. HEAR CHAIRMAN AND BOARD MEMBERS

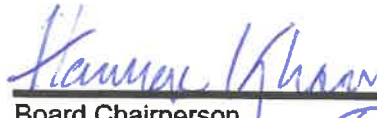

Board Member Jordan Rivera shared concerns regarding the neglect of Central Avenue Park. Parks & Recreation Director, Steve Lackey, stated that he was aware of the situation. He asked Board Member, Jordan Rivera to let the Parks & Recreation department know of concerns prior to addressing the city commission. This route delays the process of getting a resolution. In addition, Director Steve Lackey shared that this is a joint-use facility with the school district. The Parks & Recreation division does not manage the park, they only manage the playground and, out of general courtesy, the basketball courts. This park is only open to the public after school hours and weekends. Parks & Recreation relies on the school to open and close the facility. The Parks & Recreation department cleans the park on the weekends only. Director Lackey will talk with the school system in reference to the parks neglect.
