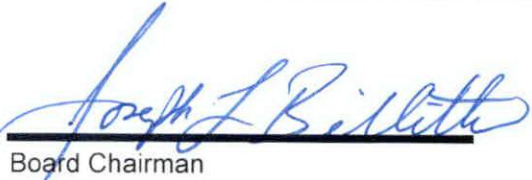
Chief O'Dell addressed harassing, public emails received by board members and advised the board members that they are under no obligation to respond or engage.

5.e Next Meeting Announcements

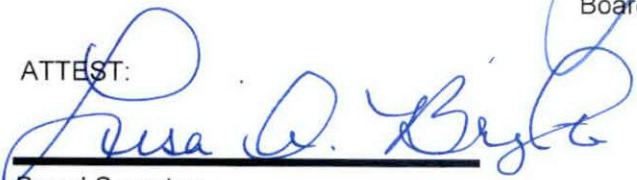
Board Chairman Billittier announced next CPRB Meeting on 10-05-2022.
