Chairperson Joseph Billittier called the meeting to order at 9:02 AM.

5.a Consent Agenda

5.a.i Board Meeting Schedule for 2023

Board Member Council made a motion to accept the CPRB Schedule 2023-2024. Board Member Camero seconded the motion. Motion to accept CPRB Schedule 2023-2024 passed 4 - 0.

5.a.ii Discussion of City of Kissimmee Policy 903, Citizen's Police Review Board

Curtis McGehee presented the policy changes / updates. The board has discussed and voted unanimously to have the right to advance, cancel a Citizen's Police Review Board Meeting in the event that there are no cases or information to be produced or discussed.

5.a.iii Citizens Police Review Board Post Meeting Review Report

Curtis McGehee presented the policy review in regards to adding reports drafted by the board secretary to the Chief of Kissimmee Police Department, with the board's findings. Motion to add report by the Board Secretary passed 4-0.

5.b Review of Investigations & Appearances

5.b.i Review IA 22-013 Handling Money, Property, and Evidence

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 22-013, Officer Leopoldo Roman. Sergeant Rush filed the complaint. Open for discussion were addressed on Officer Roman's past complaints to the board as well. Officer Roman was found in Violation of General Order Handling of Money, Property and Evidence when Officer Roman placed the prisoner's cellphone on top of his patrol vehicle during his search incident

to arrest and drove off resulting the loss of the prisoner's cellphone. Officer Roman was issued an oral reprimand. The board voted to approve the findings of IA 22-013 and did not provide additional comments.

5.b.ii Review IA 22-017 Standard of Conduct

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 22-017, Bayron Baez. Open discussion with the board regarding complainant allegations from Nayelli Martinez. Ms. Martinez stated Officer Baez made uncomfortable interactions and made inappropriate contact towards Ms. Martinez at her place of employment. Officer Baez was found in Violation of General Orders, Standard of Conduct and was issued a written reprimand. On November 7th, 2022, Officer Baez separated from the agency. The board voted to approve the findings of IA 22-017 and did provide additional comments.

5.b.iii Review IA 22-018 Investigations 22-018 Obedience to Policies and Procedures, General Orders and other Written Directives

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 22-018, Officer Dariel Quiles Davila, which found Officer Quiles in violation of General order of Obedience, Policies, Procedures, General Orders, and other Written Directives. The investigation found that Officer Quiles did not use his body worn camera and failed to complete a report, as required by policy, during a call for service at 1709 North John Young Parkway and Officer Quiles was issued a reprimand. The board voted to approve the findings of IA 22-018 and did provide additional comments.

5.b.iv Review IA 22-011 Employee Misconduct

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 22-011 Employee Misconduct, Plenio Massiah. Witness James Cox, 3102 Pebble Court Kissimmee, made a public comment, expressing his side of the allegations and also appreciation for the City of Kissimmee Police Department for their handling of this case and the positive resolution. Open discussion. Motion to accept the Investigation Findings: Passed 4-0.

5.b.v Review IA 23-005 Standards of Conduct

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 23-005, Officer Shaffer and Officer Raul Vazquez. Explanation provided for the differing penalties between the two officers, wherein there were separate violations. Officer Shaffer admitted to saying "do your thing" to the arrestee and declining to take the arrestee to the restroom. Officer Shaffer was found in Violation of General Order Standard of Conduct and was issued a written reprimand. Officer Vazquez admitted to using profane language toward Sergeant Harris when declining to take the arrestee to use the restroom and was found in Violation of General Order Standard of Conduct and was issued an eight-hour suspension. The board voted to approve the findings of IA 22-005 and did provide additional comment.

5.b.vi Review IA 23-004 Standards of Conduct

Sergeant Padilla presented Case IA 23-004, Officer Dennis Vazquez which found Officer Vazquez in violation of the General Order Conduct towards the public. Officer Vazquez was issued a reprimand. The board voted to approve the findings of IA 22-004 and did provide additional comment.

5.c Other Business

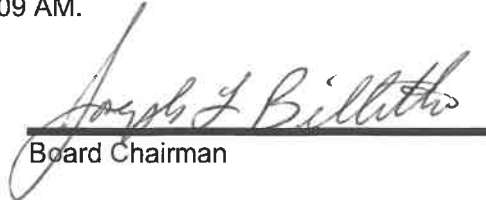
